La Trobe University science undergraduate (completing second or third year) students are invited to apply for a cadetship with the Research Centre for Applied Alpine Ecology.

Students will be trained in field ecology techniques and undertake monitoring and research under the guidance of the Research Centres scientific research staff.

Our scientific research covers a range of topics and issues including:

- Ecological processes
- Effects of disturbances (e.g. fire or frost events) on vegetation
- Exotic plants and animal invasions
- Endangered species management
- Effects of human activities
- Management of ecosystems in response to climate change

Skills learned during the cadetship may include:

- Plant identification
- Quantitative measurements of plant populations and environmental attributes
- Vegetation monitoring techniques
- GIS mapping and analysis
- Data entry and manipulation
